Wichita Downtown Development Corporation, 2012.

Hired to bring landscape architecture perspective to the development momentum in Downtown Wichita, my primary job was to generate new strategies for development issues and provide graphical expression of these ideas. During the course of my internship, I led 3 projects: A New Vision for the Macy's Garage, Site Design and Historic Restoration of the Commerce Plaza, and A Reinterpretation of the West Bank Development. The latter 2 projects were largely adopted by the developers.

Green Infrastructure: New Strategies for Infrastructure Investment In Wichita, Masters Report 2012-2013.

Extensive research into green infrastructure physical implementation and policy was conducted. A focus on developing a geospatial suitability analysis for green infrastructure implementation led a site design and cost benefit analysis. Continued collaboration with the WDDC and the City of Wichita guided progression to ensure practicality and value. The resulting report was presented to the WDDC and the City of Wichita with the intentions of suggesting a more efficient use of infrastructure investment.

cityEcologies Summer Studio, 2011.

An accelerated studio based on a series of self-generated critical maps and landscape architecture theory intended to produce a vision of design potential for downtown Kansas City. Working with professionals and city stakeholders, designs were created in small groups and presented to Kansas City.

Denver Metro Studio.

An urban design studio working in a series of scales to produce a revitalized Arapahoe Square, adjacent to Colorado's Central Business District. Working from a large scale and collaborating with EDAW and architecture students down to an individual design within the groups' master plan, focusing on fine-grain site tectonics.
